## White wines

125ml Glass

Chasselas, Cave de la Côte, Switzerland 12.5%Vol	2017	£9.95
A delicate expression of Switzerland's signature grape, with white peach and white blossom on the nose and freshness and roundness on the palate.		
Château Doisy-Daene Sec, Denis Dubourdieu Barsac, Bordeaux, France 13.5%Vol	2016	£10.55
Made by the master of dry white Bordeaux, Doisy sec combines the herbal-tropical flavours of Sauvignon with subtle smoky oak and a deliciously opulent texture, while remaining crisp, dry and fresh.		
Les Hauts de Smith, Chateau Smith Haut Lafitte, Pessac Léognan Bordeaux, France 13.5%Vol	2016	£13.95
Such a striking nose! Tense and dynamic, with a nice acidity and great freshness. The beautiful maturity of the grapes is found in a good fat and unctuous size which is carried by the freshness. Aromas of white fruits, lemon, grapefruit with great complexity brought by floral notes of acacia and spicy notes.		
Freestone Vineyards Chardonnay, Joseph Phelps California, United States 14%Vol	2016	£18.90
100% Chardonnay. This exceptionally balanced Chardonnay has real depth and grip, married to incisive acidity and well-defined complex flavours of citrus, apricot and brioche. Full-bodied yet refined and mineral.		
Cervaro della Sala (Chardonnay/Grechetto), Marchesi Antinori Umbria IGT, Italy 12.5%Vol	2016	£20.50
Intense, complex aroma with notes of white flowers and flint balanced by a hint of vanilla. Full bodied and well-structured palate with notes of toast, citrus and mineral. Elegant and persistent in the mouth.		
Meursault , Charmes 1 <sup>er</sup> Cru, Château Meursault Burgundy, France 13.5%Vol	2014	£22.30
Pure gold arising from the best Burgundy soils of the prestigious Chateau de Meursault. Golden in colour with aromas of honey, yellow fruits and fresh almonds with just a hint of wood. This wine explodes in the mouth to reveal a delicate balance of richness with a fresh long finish. Don't miss it!		
Riesling, Clos Saint Landelin, Grand Cru, Domaine Muré Alsace, France <b>Organic</b> 13 %Vol	2014	£15.95
Farmed organically, this renowned vineyard produces dry Riesling of great character, layering concentrated lime juice with warm minerality, rich yet incisive on the palate.		
Mas de Daumas Gassac, V. Guibert de la Vaissière Languedoc, France 13.5%Vol	2016	£17.50
The nose delivers dried fruit, white flowers then exotic and smoke notes sparingly. A captivating wine embellishing the palate with delicious flavours. Very soft and intense freshness. A successful offering which can be drunk now or good for laying down.		

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## Red wines

### Beaune-Fèves, 1er Cru, Château de Meursault

Burgundy, France 13.5%Vol 2015 £17.30

A cuvée that Robert Parker described as 'excellent' - what do you say? Discover all the charm of Beaune in this bottle of gratifying, seductive red. Its delicate texture, velvety length and remarkable balance make it THE wine to have in the cellar for a more sophisticated meal, or simply for a well-deserved moment of unwinding.

### Cote-Rotie, Tardieu-Laurent,

Rhone Valley, France 12.5.%Vol 2016 £19.35

This beautifully structured Côte-Rôtie balances ripe, concentrated black-cherry and plum flavors against elegant notes of fresh thyme, rosemary and bacon. It's penetrating and freshly fruited but vibrantly balanced in acidity. The finish is long, edged by finely integrated but gripping tannins

### Château Massereau, Cuvée Socrate, Graves

Bordeaux, France 12.5.%Vol 2009 £29.95

Harvested by hand, grape by grape. This complex wine, deep garnet in colour with a fruity nose of black berries, sweet spice, pepper and liquorice notes. A brilliantly balanced wine with lusciously smooth tannins. Natural wine. No chaptalization No acidification, no fining, no filtration, no added oenological product

### Badia a Passignano, Gran Selezione, Antinori

2016 £17.50

Chianti Classico D.O.C.G., Toscana, Italy 14%Vol

This wine shows a nose with the excellent character of a Sangiovese from Chianti Classico, one with notes of wild cherries, strawberries and raspberries which mix and mingle with the typical aromas of the oak barrels. On the palate the wine flows softly and pleasurably with tannins which are both felt and supple. Savory and vibrant, the wine is long and lingering on the finish and aftertaste.

### Savigny Les Beaune, « Aux Grands Liards », J-M Giboulot, Burgundy, France **Organic**, 13%Vol

2015 £14.80

Grown at the foot of the slope north of the village, a racy wine with an interesting note of peppery spice to its dark fruit.

### Amarone della Valpolicella, Giacomo Montresor, Veneto, Italy 15.5%Vol

2015 £22.95

A dense plum/black colour and a complex nose showing notes of blackberry, plum fruit and violets. The palate is smooth and round with a rich raisiny character and lovely supple tannins.

### Shiraz, Heathcote, Trentham Estate, Murray River, New South Wales, Australia 14.8%Vol

2010 £12.60

Fans of Syrah from the Rhone Valley will appreciate this rather special Shiraz- it buzzes with warm ripe fruit and a touch of spice.

### Malbec, Enrique Foster, Finca Los Barrancos Mendoza, Argentina, 14%Vol

2017 £13.25

Dark berry aromas are moderately reduced, leaving notes of olive and iodine on the nose. A full but fresh mouthfeel and spicy, lightly herbal plum and berry flavors work towards a finish that shows salty overtones and a little wildness befitting a vineyard-designated wine.

### Fleurie Vieilles Vignes, G.Descombes Beaujolais, France, 13%Vol

2014 £15.25

First, a very vibrant ruby colour, Second, a very expressive nose, with notes of cherry and wood. And finally a juicy, spicy palate, with subtle and velvety tannins and an excellent length.
