Bourgogne Chardonnay, Francois Carillon 13% Vol

François' Chardonnay is made from vines of up to 50 years old, from three different sites - two parcels in Puligny and one in Meursault. A great value wine! Very pretty fruit, apple compote and warm sponge cake, refreshed by lemon zest. This has lovely balance, vanilla biscuit richness, freshness, together with an attractive air of vitality and determined focus, through to a persistent finish.

St Aubin 1er Cru en Rémily, Côte de Beaune, O. Leflaive Frères 2018

The St Aubin appellation, which is Olivier Leflaive's favourite appellation, lies high on the same slope as Puligny-Montrachet's Grand Crus and its wine offers more than a taste of its neighbour's finesse. This wine is full bodied, with subtle hazelnut-cream flavours and textural richness

Chorey les beaune, Côte de Beaune, Dom. Maillard Père & Fils 13% Vol

This wine displays classic aromas of toast and grilled nuts on the nose. On the palate the wine is minerally, with lovely buttery overtones. A classic white Burgundy!

Puligny- Montrachet, Côte de Beaune, Francois Carillon 13% Vol 2017 £125.00

White flowers on the nose, taut and chiselled, leading into a wonderfully saline, mineral, textured palate, which has both intense, expressive fruit and a super-fine, detailed structure. It comes to a point beautifully on the finish, with brisk acidity complementing a sense of driven persistence.

Chassagne-Montrachet, Dom. Bachelet Ramonet, Côte de Beaune 2018 £93.25

A full-bodied, powerful Chassagne-Montrachet. Attention to detail is paramount to Alain Bonnefoy of old-established Domaine Bachelet-Ramonet. The vineyards are tended meticulously according to sustainable techniques, aiming to achieve balance in the vineyard. Bachelet-Ramonet's are opulent wines with lucid freshness and minerality.

Hautes Côtes de Nuits, Jean Claude Boisset, **Organic wine** 2018 £54.20

In the glass, the Organic Bourgogne Hautes Côtes de Nuits is straw yellow with white highlights. It has very intense bouquet perfumes with notes of citrus zest, green apple and toasty aromas of fresh brioche. The palate has excellent tension with concentrated fruit flavours that linger on the finish.

Savigny Vergelesses 1^{er} Cru, Domaine Pierre Labet, Côte de Beaune, 2012 £109.30

This is a bright, pale yellow-gold, very pretty, leading to a nose which is hinting at apples, lemon shortcake and an attractive mineral element. The palate echoes the nose in terms of aromatics and has a minerality which evokes neighbouring Pernand and indeed Corton-Charlemagne nuances. This is approachable, supple and vibrant, attractively focused

COTE MACONNAISE

Mâcon Solutré, Maison Auvigue, Le Moulin du Pont 13% Vol 2018 £35.80

Long-established winemakers in the Mâconnais region, the Auvigue family own several exceptional vineyards around the famous rock of Solutré. Their Mâcon-Solutré is creamy and round with ripe orchard fruit, balanced by an elegant freshness.

St Véran, Vignerons des Terres Secrètes, Prissé 12.5% Vol 2017 £31.95

A rich and flavourful wine with hints of white blossom and acacia honey, green apple and tropical fruit, with a herbal complexity, enlivened by a fresh finish.

This means that each grape is highly concentrated and full of flavour. Fermented and aged in oak barrels for 8 months, this pretty, elegant wine shows great depth and richness

Les vins de Vienne is a partnership of three superstar winemakers in the northern Rhone; Yves Cuilleron, Francois Villard and Pierre Gaillard. This wine comes from a blend of three typical Rhone white varietals, Viognier, Chardonnay and Grenache, planted along the Rhone valley. It is very approachable with nice floral, fruity characteristics set on dry, mineral palate.

Crozes-Hermitage, Domaine des Entrefaux, Organic 13% Vol 2017 £44.25

Truly marvellous: the wine has a soft, inviting approach that draws you in and then thwacks you in the nicest possible way with punchy almond, honey and peach notes, finishing with a clean citrus tang

Evenly made with fairly equal parts of Clairette, Grenache Blanc, Viognier and Roussanne, all from 30 years old vineyards. Deep straw colour, stone fruit, green, and some spice on the nose. Mouth feel is just insane; Full, rich, succulent, mouth-watering. Great flavours of peach, apricot, mineral and hay. Spice, more peach, and a tiny bit of citrus on the mid-palate and through the finish.

Côtes du Rhône Blanc, "Guy Louis", Organic 13% Vol Tardieu Laurent

Orchard and stone fruit came to the fore, refreshed by white flowers and complemented by hints of cedar. Richly-textured. This is supremely well-balanced, rounded, opulent and best of all, fresh, with an uplifting, bright finish, beautifully handled

A vividly fresh and mineral white AOP Luberon with a cocktail of tangerine flower on top of smoky undernotes.

This 50-50 blend of Picpoul Blanc and Roussanne is ripe and fleshy, boasting round notes of melon, peach, pineapple and lemon custard. There's a soft, herbal accent of white flower and citrus zest that graces the lively finish.

Heidi Schröck took over her family's 10 hectare estate in 1983, in the famous Village of Rust, Burgenland, just five miles from the Hungarian border. Her south-east facing vineyards along the western banks of Lake Neusiedl form a semi-amphitheatre, which provides considerably more sunlight hours compared to the rest of Austria. This wine offers aromas of raspberries, violets and beautiful minerality resembling the schisty soils where the fruit is grown. This medium-bodied wine has a lovely vibrancy, smooth tannins and an elegant finish.

COLCHAGUA VALLEY

Camenere Adobe Reserva, Organic 14%Vol

Rich cherry fruit, hints of capsicum, clove and black pepper on the nose with a palate of smooth berry fruit, robust and full bodied with ripe well balanced tannins.

Cabernet Sauvignon, V9, Ventisquero, Colchagua Valley, 12,5%Vol 2017

Heinrich, Shiraz/Grenache/Mataro, Rolf Binder, Barossa Valley, 2014

The 2014 Heinrich is sourced from low yielding old vines and is a favoured blend from the region. Layers of peppery plum Shiraz, deep savoury spice and soft tannins of century old Mataro; and the juicy red berries and confectionnary "sweetness" of Grenache are uncovered with each mouthful.

Glenelly Glass Collection, Cabernet Franc, Stellenbosch 14,5%Vol 2017

Glenelly winery was purchased in 2003 by May de Lencquesaing, former owner of the iconic Chateau Pichon Longueville Comtesse de Lalande in France. The palate is dominated by aromas of dark cherries, blueberries and graphite together with silky tannins and it culminates in a long smooth finish.

Mont du Toit, Mont du Toit- Wellington, Paarl, 14.5%Vol

Deep garnet in colour, slightly browing at the rim. The nose is appetizing with dark fruit compote, spice and milk chocolate. The palate is juicy and moreish, with cassis, coffee and warm spice, all balanced with a lovely freshness

The Chocolate Block, Franschhoek, Western Cape,14%Vol

Blend of Syrah, Grenache, Cabernet Sauvignon, Viognier and Cinsault. An earthy, rustic nose of leather and sweet spices over a backdrop of blackcurrant and ripe raspberry. Harmonious and powerful on the palate, with a cocoa complexity and soft tannins.

Massaya Classic, Le Colombier, Bekaa Valley, 14,5%Vol

Take three dynamic winemaking families – The Hebrard from Cheval Blanc, St Emilion, The Bruniers from Vieux Telegraphe, Chateauneuf du Pape and The Ghosn Brothers from Tanail, Bekaa. Create a franco-lebanese collaboration in 1991 that drives a wine estate to international recognition for its modern style of Lebanese wines. This wine impresses with its effusive ripe red fruit character from the Cinsault grape that constitutes the majority of the blend. Very much made as a vin de plaisir focussing on fruit rather than the oak notes this nevertheless has enough presence to ably accompany spiced Mediterranean meat dishes or cheese. Chateau Musar, Gaston Hochar, Bekaa Valey, 14%Vol

This has become such an iconic wine for a number of reasons – not least the vision and persistence of Gaston Hochar to grow grapes and make wine in a war zone, whilst at times literally dodging bullets, yet continually striving for quality. To-day the conditions are much improved, and Chateau Musar delivers a rich cornucopia of flavour from three grape varieties (Cabernet Sauvignon, Cinsault and Carignan) which once matured in bottle, are a pleasure, an experience and a salute to a dedicated team.

Sweet, onctuous, enjoyable. Amber colour, delicious tangyflavour with sufficient "bite" to hide the degree of sugar. The pleasure comes from freshness and sweetness combined.

Muscat de Rivesaltes l' Envol des Sens, Les Domaines Auriol, 75cl bottle £36.15 Languedoc Roussillon 16% Vol 125 ml Glass £8.10

Pale gold, brilliant. The nose is very expressive with fruity notes of citrus and exotic fruits. Honeyed sweetness balanced by a nice freshness. An elegant Muscat with good length where the fruit and citrus predominate over the sweetness

Maury, Grenat, Vendange, Vin Doux Naturel 16%Vol 2014 50cl bottle £35.80 125ml Glass £8.90

Made from 100% Grenache grapes. Red and black fruit nose. In mouth, it is like crunching a fresh Grenache berry. Ample, with soft tannins and very long after taste. Fantastic combination with any kind of dark chocolate dessert and blue cheese. Absolutely delicious!

Chateau Miaudoux Saussignac, Gérard & Nathalie Cuisset, 2011 50cl bottle £38.05 Bergerac, **Organic** 13% Vol £8.55

Château Miaudoux is found in a beautiful spot on the sunny slopes of the Saussignac appellation in the Dordogne. Despite its tiny size Saussignac is an important wine village in the area and is especially famous for its delicate sweet wines.

This wine comes exclusively from oldest vines exposed South-East, on clay-limestone soil. Beautiful golden colour, intense peach and tangerine nose, candied fruits. Beautiful length. A luscious and concentrated dessert wine.

Chateau Septy, Monbazillac, 13% Vol 2013 75cl bottle £39.30 37.5cl bottle £19.75 125ml Glass £8.80

Winner of the Gold medal at the "Concours des Grands Vins de France" 2010. An elegant and generous wine. It has notes of exotic fruit like lychees. The mouth is rich, complex, and very long. Served as an aperitif, it is also the ideal companion of foie gras
